Jill,

To confirm the conversation from today I thought I would write out my understanding of the speed profile

The top speed of the service would be 250km/h, from Kitchener to Windsor the alignment of the new dedicated corridor would not preclude increasing this in the future. Between Kitchener and Georgetown the top speed would be 250km/h, subject to further analysis (up to 200km/hr is attainable). From Georgetown to Toronto Union station speeds of up to 200km/h will be possible in line with the current plans for RER.

Please can the team include Laura/George on the calls when we tell SDG to change direction- its all getting to confusing where we are.
